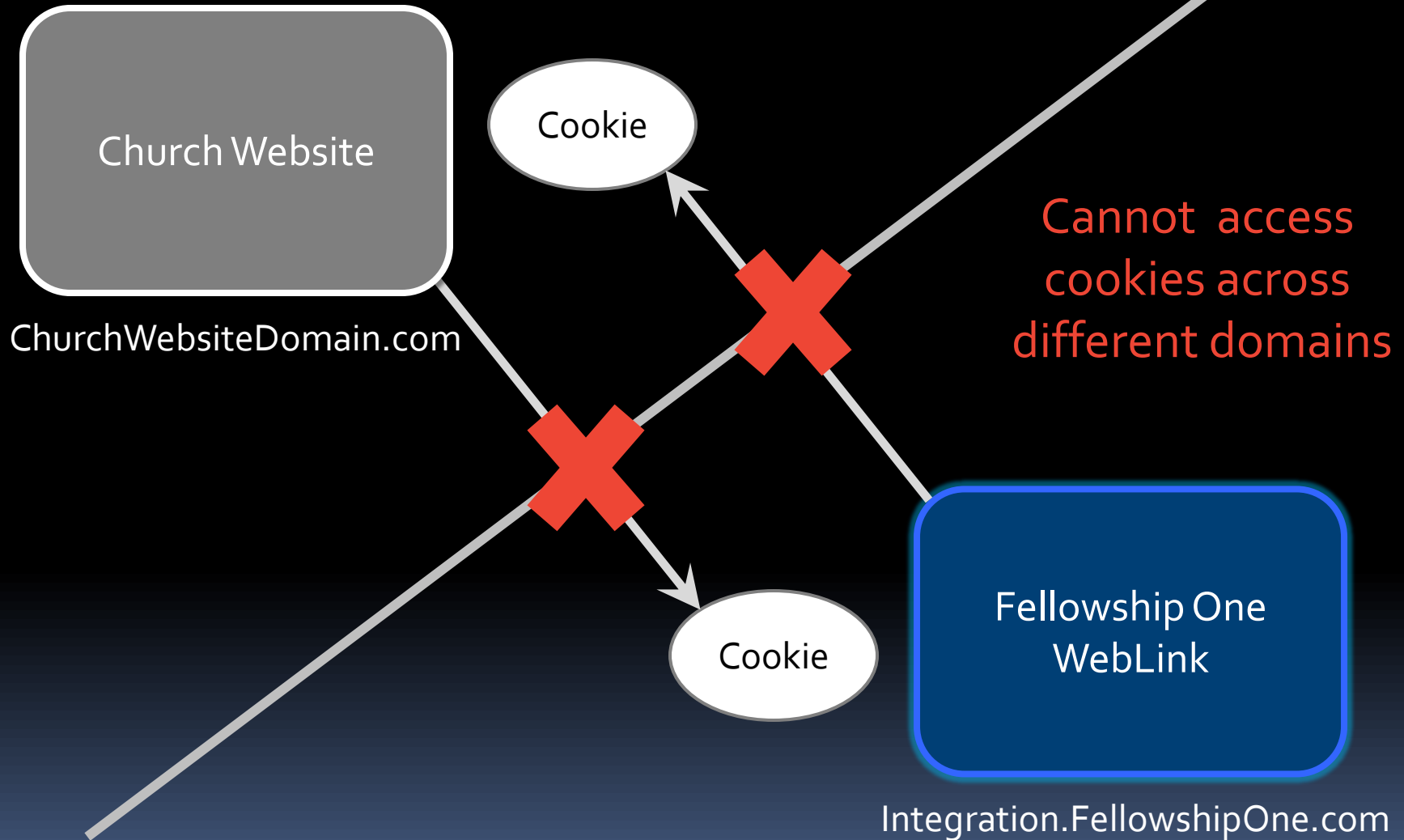

Pop-up Login : Pros & Cons

Pros

- Little or no development experience required
- Up and running within 30 minutes
- Virtually maintenance free
- Simulates single sign-on across all WebLink modules

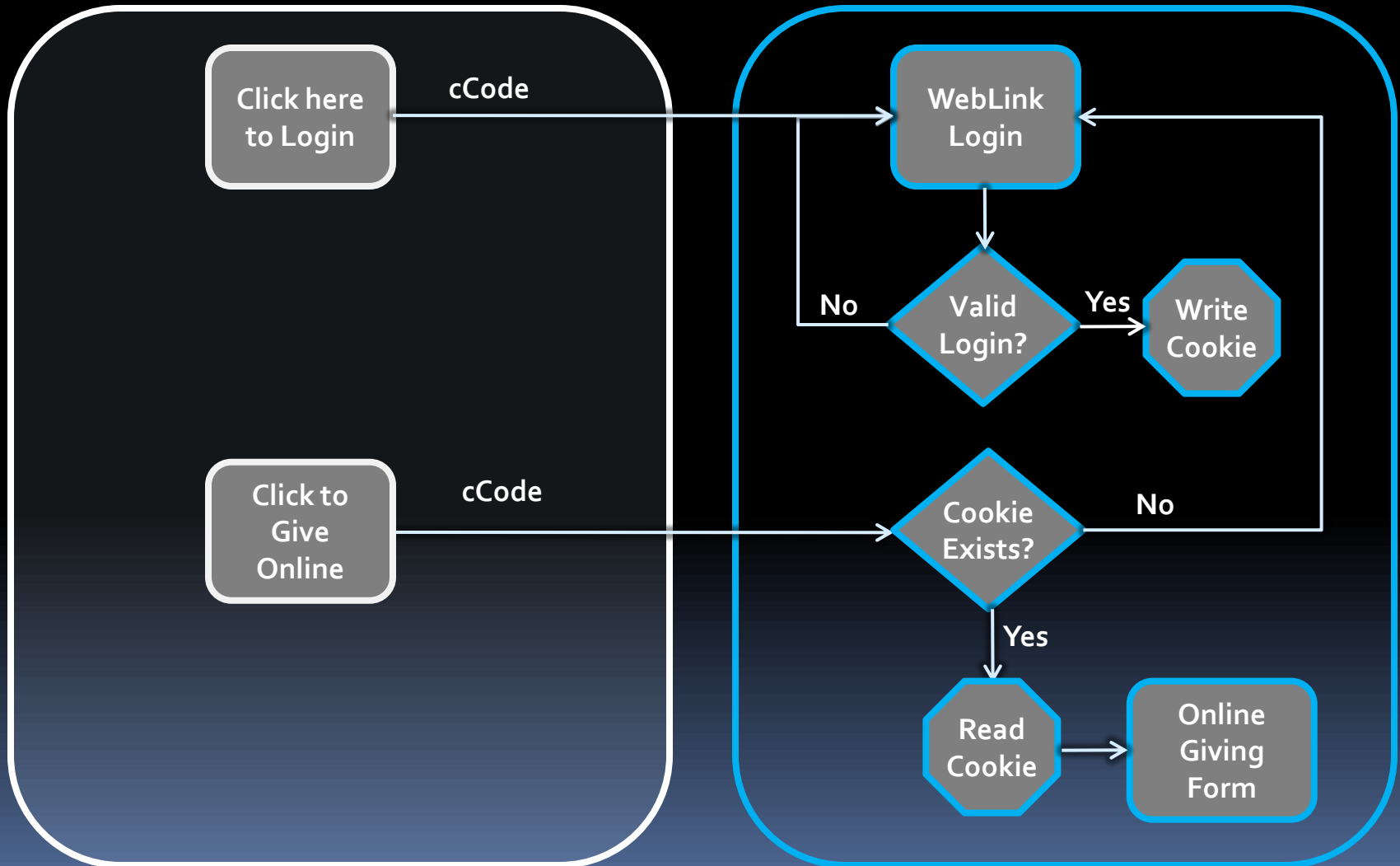
Cons

- Church website cannot detect if user is logged on
- No user personalization information is available
- Links to WebLink features may cause redirect to Login

Embedded Login : Pros & Cons

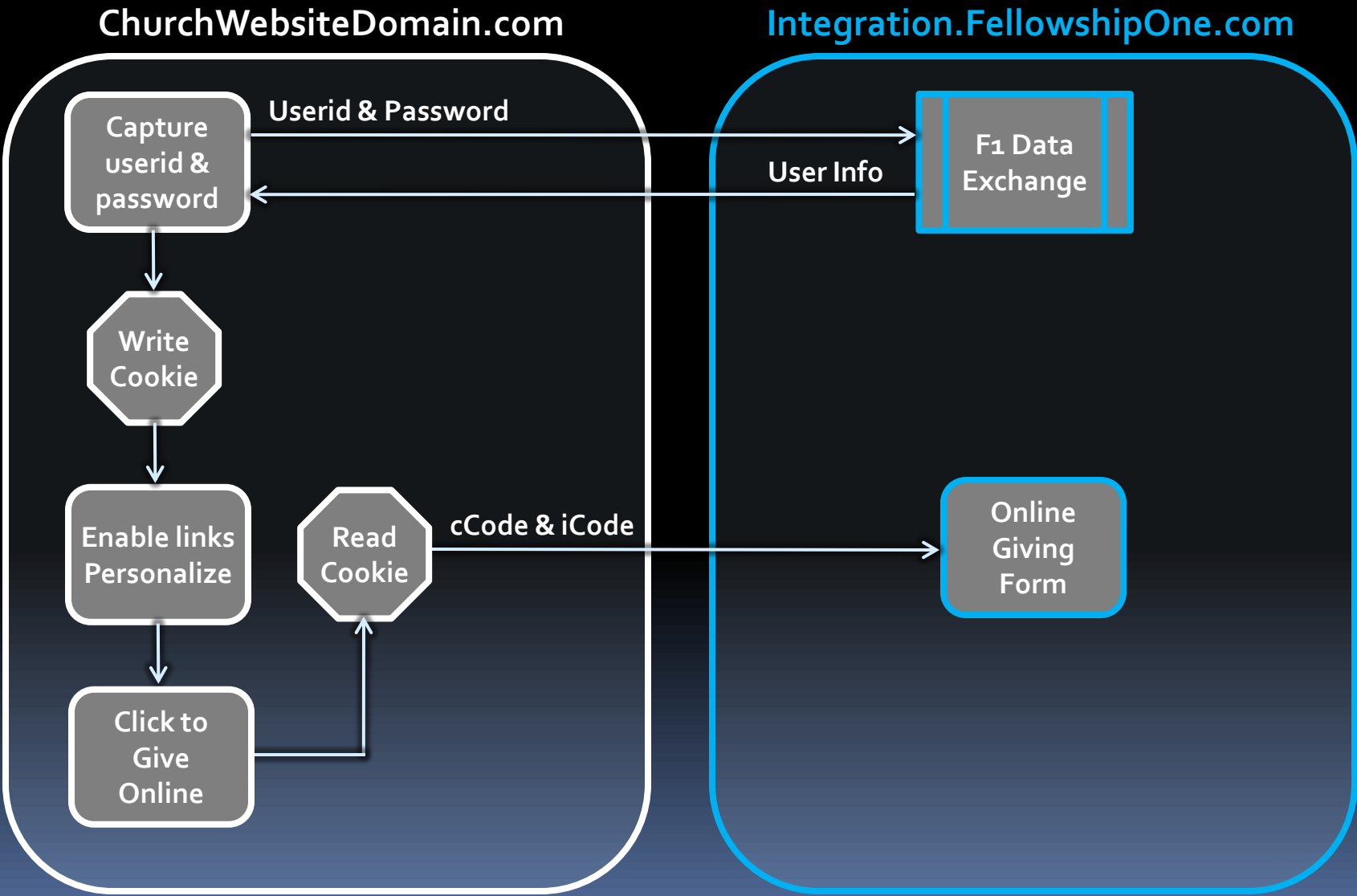
Pros

- Complete control over login design and experience
- Access to user information allows for personalized website experience
- Can hide/show or enable/disable links based on login status
- Leverages DataExchange which opens the door for other possibilities

Cons

- Church website cannot detect if user is logged on
- No user personalization information is available
- Links to WebLink features may cause redirect to Login
